This will continue the ongoing tradition of underwriting the ministry administration so that 100% of the contributions will be given to orphanages and relating projects.

In this interest, we have prepared this report to provide an overview of our ministry to widows and orphans around the world.

We respectfully request your prayerful consideration of becoming our partner, so together, we can feed, clothe, shelter, educate and provide healthcare to those widows and orphans who have no other hope for life and a future.

Your timely response is needed. Around the world, a child dies from starvation every three seconds.

Together, we can help change that statistic.



History of Partners in Action

In 1985, Partners in Action began working in south Phoenix, one of the worst crime areas in Arizona. Illegal drugs and violent crime were rampant during that era. The danger was so severe that paramedics and the fire department wouldn't even answer a 911 emergency call without a police escort. But we saw a need and met the need.

Partners in Action purchased the "Keys Market" in partnership with several other agencies and converted the market into a community center to provide ministry services to the surrounding neighborhood. Through teams of volunteers, we renovated some of the homes in the vicinity: we added bathrooms, patched walls, replaced doors and windows, and fixed leaky roofs.

Since this first project for the needy of our community, our scope of service has grown significantly in the past twenty years. We have since developed community outreach programs, a thrift store, a soup kitchen, youth camps and many affordable housing projects.

Today, we partner with others to build, manage, oversee and support orphanages and schools in hurting parts of the world. When we travel to meet the orphaned children we serve, they cling to us and with large eyes plead, "Will you help us?" We know that most of these kids are going to die in the next few years unless proper resources reach them in time.

It is with this urgency that we seek partners to stand with us to meet 100% of our administrative match grant challenge.

Together, we can change the fact that a child is dying from starvation every three seconds.



Purpose of this Report

It is with a deep appreciation that Partners in Action has received a Match Grant of \$250,000 to be used for the underwriting of our administration costs.

This gracious gift will allow Partners in Action to continue to send 100% of all sponsorship dollars to the orphanages under our care.

The challenge we have is to find and confirm corporate and organizational partners who believe in our Vision and embrace it as synonymous with their principles.

Our partners will contribute at their determined level, and it will be matched dollar for dollar up to \$250,000.

As you review this report, remember the need is desperate. While you were reading this page, a child died from starvation every 3 seconds, or 20 children perished per minute.

Together, we can save these at-risk children and give them hope and a future as we feed clothe, shelter, educate and provide healthcare for them.

By helping us underwrite our administration costs, we can send more resources into the orphanages and projects extending care to those who cannot care for themselves.

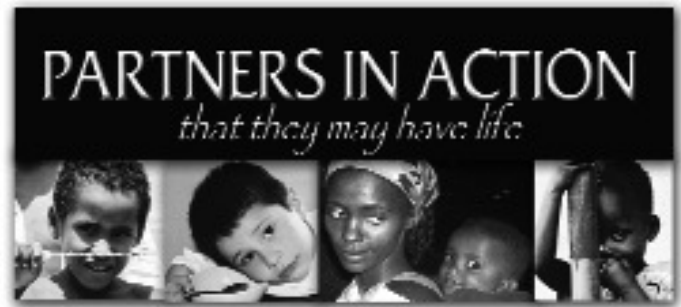


Vision
