PIA Executive Trip to Southern Africa


(Provided for 6 individuals on the Platinum Sponsorship and 2 on the Gold Sponsorship)

In 2021 members of the PIA board and executive team will travel to South Africa and the Kingdom of Eswatini.

The trip itinerary is as follows:

- Land in Johannesburg, South Africa
- Drive via private transportation to Mbabane, Eswatini
 - 1 night in the Capital City and experience the Swazi Cultural Village
- Drive via private transportation to Bulembu, Eswatini
 - Spend a minimum of 2 nights in Bulembu experiencing the town and seeing the ministry programs
- Drive via private transportation to the Kruger National Park
 - Spend a minimum of 1 night at a Safari Lodge
- Drive via private transportation to Johannesburg Airport

Partners in Action will cover all travel and in-country expenses (lodging, food, etc.), not including airfare and Safari Lodge expenses, and travel/medical insurance related to the trip, to those who receive a private invitation to this trip.

Incoming Executive Director, Joshua Ward, brings with him a unique take on sustainable development in Southern Africa.


Joshua is a third generation Swazi citizen and has grown up in one of Partner's in Action's largest projects.


Over the past 20 years, sub-Saharan nations have successfully grown their economies, reducing the number of people in extreme poverty (defined as less than \$1.90/day). However, the last few months of COVID-19 have decimated the progress that had been achieved.

It is estimated that 37 million people have been forced back into extreme poverty in 2020 alone. Sub-Saharan Africa remains disproportionately effected by the pandemic, as countries are not able to borrow money to mitigate the economic damage done by COVID-19.

It is no secret that much of the general African economy revolves around the informal sector. Data now shows us that more than 80% of earnings of informal workers was lost in the first month of the pandemic alone.

For the last 33 years Partners in Action has cared for the most vulnerable people around the world. In 2006 we began the transformation of an abandoned mining town that now accommodates nearly 400 orphaned and vulnerable children. The town was well on its way to self-sustainability through enterprise, when the global lock-down hit. In 2019 we launched our first large-scale agricultural-based poverty alleviation program in Zambia, and are demonstrating that with minimal funds, we can effectively move families from a place of true hopelessness in extreme poverty to food security and full sustainability.

When we commit to change the lives of communities, we do it. And now there is more work to be done than ever before. Be a part of the work - be a Partner in Action.
